

Welcome Aboard The Eurostar (Bullet Train) To A

Cultural and Educational Experience

The Institute for Social Justice, Inc. (ISJ, Inc) welcomes you to a program of collaboration, partnership and networking. This program will enhance your ability to meet your counterparts in seven different international countries, to share effective strategies and best practices for lowering the incidents of crimes and to address many of the burning issues in the criminal justice and legal arenas.

Several pertinent issues that will be addressed during this journey are 1. Why Collaboration? 2. The importance of developing partnerships with professionals abroad, 3. The necessity of increasing awareness, expertise, knowledge and skills. Specific topics of concern that will be addressed are: community policing, developing good police and community relations, developing partnerships between the community and businesses, Re-entry & Rehabilitative programs, Alternative programs, Prison programs & Court programs.

You will have the opportunity to talk with court officials (judges and attorneys) about the court systems in their country and what programs have been effective and proven successful with youth(s). This is only one of many discussions you will encounter on this journey. This program was designed with you in mind. Climb aboard, Enjoy the ride!

I. Travel Information

Each participant must have a valid passport. Since our experience begins in England, each participant is responsible for his/her travel arrangements to London, England and back to the USA. If needed, the Institute can recommend a travel agency. Once participants arrive in London, the real journey begins! Accommodations at one of London's finest hotels will be handled by the ISJ for each participant in each country where hotel accommodations are required. Check-in at the hotel must be done before 3:00 pm (London time, of course).

A "What You Should Know Before You Go" information pamphlet/booklet will be mailed to all participants before departing for England. This guide will give you a brief explanation of customs regulations, passport regulations, hotel accommodations, activities, meals, sightseeing tours and how to dress for the weather.

II. What is Included in the 14-Day Package

Hotel accommodations, eurorail passes, transportation, and miscellaneous fees are covered for seven countries (England, France, Belgium, Austria, Germany, Switzerland & Italy), continental breakfast each day, whether it is at the hotel or traveling on the bullet train, and the several mini tours in some of the countries we will visit. Your journey culminates Sunday, March 28, 2010 back in London, England.

III. Eurorail Travel on the Bullet Trains

Remember, these trains travel at approximately 200 miles per hour. You'll find the scenery spectacular, the camaraderie and energy immeasurable.

When you are not lodging at a hotel, you will be dining, relaxing and sleeping on the trains. The train accommodations are **1st Class.** Meals served on the trains and a variety of beverages and snacks are included.

IV. Transportation

The ISJ will arrange for transportation from the hotel to the trains and from the trains to the hotels as well as to and from the locations where participants will be meet with their professional counterparts. Mini tours in several of the countries we will be visiting are also provided. Of course, most international cities offer a variety of tours and sightseeing adventures. If you choose to take a tour which is not covered in the package, you must pay that cost out-of-pocket.

V. Cost - \$2,500 per participant

Wow! A 14-day experience at a 7-day price. You have the option of paying in full or selecting a payment plan. Payments, in the form of personal checks, money orders and bank drafts, can be made in installments up to 45 days prior to departure. That means all payments must be in no later than January 28, 2010. Major credit cards – Visa, MasterCard and American Express are acceptable forms of payment. However, no PERSONAL CHECKS after December 31, 2009.
